OFFICE ORDER

In view of the establishing of Regional Directorate vide office order no. 26/20009-Adm.I (F.No. 1-5/20022-Adm. I) dated 2nd March, 2009 and in supersession of the office orders issued from time to time in the past concerning the delegation of financial powers to officials for carrying out works in the field of conservation, preservation, horticulture, exploration and excavation, museums and epigraphy, as per Rule 13(3) of Delegation of Financial Powers Rules, 1978, (DFPR), the Director General, Archaeological Survey of India, further delegates with immediate effect the financial powers to various officers as mentioned below:-

Delegated financial powers of Director General, Archaeological Survey of India, vide Ministry of Culture's office order F. No. 12-1/89-Plg. (pt, 2006) dated 17th August, 2007.


